II.A	Not Be Pregnant	Removed this qualification for membership.
II. B.	Members cannot use tobacco on a regular basis, vape, or use federally illegal drugs.	Members cannot use illegal drugs.
III. D.		Added: One annual/well visit will be eligible for sharing for members 6 years and older per membership year. Includes \$150 allowance for the following routine labs as ordered by provider during the annual/well visit. • Complete Blood Count with Differential and Platelets • Comprehensive Metabolic Panel • Lipid Profile with Lipoprotein Particle Assessment • Hemoglobin A1C • Vitamin D-25 OH • C-Reactive Protein • Fecal Occult Blood Test • Pap Smear • PSA Members under the age of 6 receive one annual visit. Additional visits will follow routine well-child guidelines.
